Mr. Gene F. Barbagallo, 3216 Lions Den Road, Imperial – gave an update regarding a lagoon on the south end of his property line. The lagoon was permitted by the County but wants to know why the County would allow lagoons to be built in high-growth areas, where it could poison hillsides, streams and spring branches. Mr. Barbagallo stated he has been in contact with environmental specialists and has them on record pulling test of the water and stated it is excellent water. The lagoon has not yet come online, but will be when the man moves in. The lagoon will be dumping into an existing woods drainage which will enter his property at around 150 feet. The water will continue to be tested by environmental specialists.

Kent (*refused to give his last name or address*) - stated the Courthouse on the northwest

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corner has a picnic table that has a cable, which can be a trip hazard. He also mentioned the bench on the southeast side of the table has a large hole in it.

XI. REPORTS FROM COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Gave an update regarding the Sales Tax, through May 2025.

We are now in our fifth month of collecting sales tax on recreational marijuana and a trend is developing. The numbers are not what we expected, hoped for or predicted. As of last month, we received \$333,821 (through May). If this trend continues, we may collect \$1 million before the end of the year. However, if the court decides that the counties can keep the stackable sales money, we will likely be able to keep the \$1 million. But there is a lawsuit about whether we can stack or not stack and that reflects what is in the city and in the county. If that happens, we might have to give half of that back. Until the lawsuit is decided, we have to make sure we do not spend this money.

This Saturday, (May 17, 2025), Hillsboro Armed Forces Day will be held at Hillsboro Middle School at 12:30 p.m. This is to honor those who have served or are serving.
