District 4 - Councilman Charles Groeteke:

Stated the Ad Hoc Master Plan Committee met prior to the Council Meeting and approved documents to go forward to the Administration for questions and revisions to the Master Plan. We will be meeting in the future to discuss what comes back. Mr. Groeteke thanked Mr. Giancola and Mr. Leaderbrand for participating in the committee and providing a lot of input.

Stated after hearing about some problems with the St. Louis County Animal Shelter had, he reached out to see how the conditions were at Jefferson County's Animal Shelter. The Department of Agriculture report he received said there were no non-compliance items identified.

Mr. Groeteke attended a public meeting regarding proposed road improvements on Highway M in the Barnhart area. He noted that the Public Works Department received positive feedback from a local resident who commended the County's efforts to minimize impacts on nearby properties while addressing safety concerns on the curve. Mr. Groeteke noted that the Council received a report from the Sheriff's Department summarizing its activities over the past few months.

Provided an update on the storm that came through southern Jefferson County. On June 7, 2025, there was an EF1 tornado. Emergency Management conducted a damage assessment with SEMA on Sunday morning. It appears that the impact of the tornado was limited. There were six residential properties with damage. However, no injuries were reported. The tornado also damaged cabins at Camp Neotez.

Gave a shout-out to the Road Crews. Mr. Gannon stated he was on Big River Heights Road after the storm and there were minimal signs of debris.

Sales tax is down this month compared to last year. This is not the only gauge used to judge where we are at, but it shows how people are spending.

The recreational cannabis sales year-to-date are \$486,619. This includes the money received, which is considered stacking and non-stacking.

Thanked the Road Department again for all the work and safety measures taken while repairing Highway W. In addition, Romaine Creek Road has a severe failure on the

If an official reaches the twelve-year limit in one position, they would still be eligible to run for a different County elected position, with a separate twelve-year limit applicable to that new office.
