VI. REPORTS AND COMMENTS FROM COUNCIL MEMBERS

Councilman Crow thanked County Services and Code Enforcement Director Mitch Bair and Staff for everything they do regarding concerns and complaints on property issues, especially when they issues day-to-day issues and the quality of life of our constituents.

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District 4 - Councilman Charles Groeteke:

Mr. Groeteke reported that the Director of County Services informed him a revised draft of the Master Plan has been received from the consultants. He noted that the County Council may receive copies as early as Tuesday, allowing the Master Plan Committee to begin its review.

Mr. Groeteke mentioned he had visited the park in Kimmswick and saw where the new flagpole was going to be installed.

Mentioned he attended the EPA Community Meeting last Wednesday and the Little Theater in Arts and Sciences.

District 5 - Councilman Scott Seek:

District 6 - Councilman Tim Brown:

Stated he agrees with the comments that Mr. Crow made tonight and said one thing we need to do is properly fund our departments. If the Council is going to create regulations, we need to understand what it is going to cost to enforce and properly fund them, or don't pass legislation if we are not going to fund it.

District 7 - Councilman Bob Tullock:

Attended an EPA meeting. Also in attendance were EPA Coordinator Elizabeth Kramer, Missouri DNR, and EPA Project Manager Greg Bach. One of the funds Mr. Bach is involved with is the Southwest Jefferson County Mining Superfund. They are in the process of doing an engineering evaluation cost analysis, measuring the risk to human health and the environment. He stated there are 9 million pounds of lead that has made its way into the water shed.

Mr. Tullock stated he is still interested in is the Waste Transfer Station and Storage Containers and said we are desperately lacking in regulations regarding both.

Thanked the Councilmembers who attended Lincoln Days and the NRA events this weekend and mentioned it was a great success.

Mentioned if there is an interest in a Work Session in August, it will be on the 18th, and to let him know.

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VII. PUBLIC COMMENTS

First Speaker - address not provided, stated he has no grievances with the County Council. However, his concern is that we are violating everyone's rights the minute anyone walks into the building. He stated the purpose of government is to protect our rights and to provide a system of justice and spoke about the first and fourth amendment.

Mr. Gene Barbagallo - 3216 Lions Den Road, Imperial, Mr. Barbagallo said when he was on the Council last year the topic regarding setting term limits was discussed, and voted on not to proceed with the topic. Mr. Barbagallo stated he does not understand why it is being discussed again, only a year later, when there are more important things needing to be discussed.

Mr. Barbagallo also spoke regarding tornado sirens and mentioned they are a throwback from World War II's air raid sirens. Mr. Barbagallo stated the first tornado siren was established in 1970 and asked why we are embracing fifty or eighty year old technology when the majority of people have a cell phone where they can be alerted of an emergency.

Ms. Dawn Chadd - 1463 Scenic Drive, Arnold, mentioned she feels some of the ordinances we have in place are not being followed through and enforced.

Ms. Tara Lang - 2849 Platin View Drive, Festus, employed by Chestnut Health Systems. Ms. Lang spoke about a client and friend that lost his life after being struck by a car. He was unhoused and had been living near Northwest Library. Ms. Lang advocated for transitional housing in our community.

XI. REPORTS FROM COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Stated there has been information about the proposed Gateway Regional Law Enforcement Academy. This was first shared with the County Council in a letter by Sheriff Marshak in December 2024, and was introduced with a joint press release in April 2025 to the St. Louis media. The shared vision of a multi-jurisdictional law enforcement training facility will enhance public safety by providing high-quality consistent and collaborative training, offering new recruits' training and current officers continuing education.

Mr. Gannon mentioned there are some re-appointments and appointments on the

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agenda, one of which is Jeffrey Spraul. Due to a change in the Code Mr. Spraul became ineligible to seek his current seat on the Planning and Zoning Commission for District 5. Mr. Gannon requests that Mr. Spraul is placed in the At-Large position, where he meets the requirements. In addition, Executive Director Stacey Ismail provided a recommendation for the appointment of Mr. Jon Casey to the Jefferson County Developmental Disability Advocates. Mr. Gannon stated he did not know Mr. Casey personally, however, has known the family for a number of years and knows nothing but positive things about them.

Councilman Brown requested clarification on whether the Consent Agenda requires unanimous approval or if a majority vote is sufficient. Counselor Jasha Kuenzel responded that unanimous approval is required. Councilman Brown raised questions about on-call contracts. He asked the administration to clarify what “on-call” means and how these contracts are intended to be used. Executive Gannon explained that on-call services are not limited to emergency situations. They are also used to ensure tasks are completed in a timely manner. For example, the City has an on-call contract for the maintenance of seven generators. Under this agreement, the contractor services the generators a set number of times each year. Without such a contract, individual requests would need to be submitted each time maintenance is required. Purchasing Manager Jackie Doyle added that there are multiple vendors on each of the on-call contracts. Finally, Councilman Brown asked about the criteria for deciding when a project should go out to bid versus when an on-call contract is used. He noted that this question did not need to be answered immediately and requested that a response be sent to him via email.
