VI. **REPORTS AND COMMENTS FROM COUNCIL MEMBERS**

District 1 - Councilman Brian Haskins:

Spoke about the favorable response regarding the Community Parking Lot and Pocket Park located on High Ridge Blvd and mentioned in the beginning it was not like that. There were many people who thought it was a waste of time, money and resources.

District 3 - Councilwoman Lori Arons:

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In January 2023 Mrs. Arons attended a public MoDot meeting about adding two new stoplights on Jeffco. She went to this meeting as a concerned citizen for her community. Last Thursday, she was invited to speak at MoDot's safety ribbon cutting ceremony as the Councilwoman for District 3.

District 4 - Councilman Charles Groeteke:

Announced there has been an extended closure on Old Lemay Ferry Road due to utility conflicts.

He received an update from Public Works that the update to the Master Plan has been delayed. We are waiting for some of the problems to be addressed by the consultants and they are hopeful the draft will be received sometime this week.

A new flag pole has been installed at Kimmswick Park.

District 5 - Councilman Scott Seek:

Reminded everyone to exercise caution while traveling through the construction on I-55. This past weekend a tragic accident claimed a life. Please slow down, remain alert and always wear your seatbelt.

This coming weekend, August 17th, Jefferson County Growth Association will host the annual Bottleneck Bridge Ride. Events like this are possible because of the collaboration between our cities, the County and our Tourism Board, particularly the Festus Tourism Commission. This is also a reminder of the potential benefits a Countywide Bed Tax could provide in supporting similar events and tourism initiatives.

Spoke regarding some nuisance properties in both his district and in district 2. Mr. Tullock displayed pictures of these properties and mentioned there were some constituents in his district at the Council meeting who would be speaking about them during Public Comments.

Ms. Melissa Bax - 8905 Riverview Drive, Cedar Hill, spoke about a neighbor's dog that is not kept on a leash and runs around loose. She also stated the same neighbor has water that leaks out of their well onto the street. In the winter, when the water on the road freezes, it is dangerous to drive. Another concern is the safety of the children at the bus stop which is located near this residence.

Mr. Billy Scheidil - 6312 South River Drive, Cedar Hill, spoke about a public nuisance home in his neighborhood, located at 9085 Hickory Drive.

Mr. Kevin Hurley - 12537 Peter Moore Lane, De Soto, spoke about the proposed law enforcement training facility and mentioned other things the money should be used for.

Ms. Danielle Elliot - 205 Bailey Road, Crystal City, spoke against the law enforcement training facility. She stated she had researched other states with this type of shared training facility and said the cost was much higher than anticipated.

Mr. Robert Wagner - 6274 Cedar Drive, Cedar Hill, stated our country is a country of laws and covenants and those people who want to follow the laws are usually good people. Mr. Wagner lives near 9085 Hickory Drive and asked if the County Council could please do something regarding the public nuisance house at this address.

Ms. Anne Gore - 9054 Hickory Drive, Cedar Hill, stated she lives diagonally to the nuisance home at 9085 Hickory Drive. Ms. Gore stated they had contacted the Police, Code Enforcement, and Public Waste about the violations, but nothing has been done. She asked the Council to please help them get something done.

Mr. Kevin Barr - 9045 Hickory Drive, Cedar Hill, spoke against the public nuisance home located at 9085 Hickory Drive. Mr. Barr suggested placing a dumpster at this address and billing them for it.

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Mr. Erik Gore - 9084 Hickory Drive, Cedar Hill, stated he lives next to the public nuisance property, located at 9085 Hickory Drive. Mr. Gore stated he fears for his life every day that something will happen to him involving these neighbors. He stated we elect officials to enforce ordinances and nothing is being done.

Ms. Barbara Marco - 12537 Peter Moore Lane, De Soto, spoke against the law enforcement training facility on Bill No. 25-08209 and stated we need a new jail and courthouse is more of a priority.

Mr. Brian Taylor - 400 First Street, Hillsboro, stated he is the Captain of the Support Services Division of the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office and said he was at the meeting on behalf of Sheriff Marshak, who would like to express his strong support for the Gateway Law Enforcement Training Center. Captain Taylor explained what the training center is and the benefits it will have.

Bill No. 25-08209 - Ordinance Authorizing The Execution Of An Intergovernmental Joint Cooperation And Development Assistance Agreement For The Regional Law Enforcement Training Facility

Council Member Charles Groeteke made a motion to introduce Bill No. 25-08209 by title, seconded by Councilwoman Lori Arons; Council Member Charles Groeteke read the Bill by title.

Council Member Charles Groeteke made a motion to approve 25-08209 and move to Perfection, seconded by Councilwoman Lori Arons.

Council Member Seek expressed concern that the public hasn't had an opportunity to review the mock-up of the proposed training facility. He also felt pressured to make a quick decision on the matter. While he strongly supports law enforcement, he questioned the need for an expensive facility located in Des Peres. Mr. Seek said he does not see the clear benefit of the project for Jefferson County and noted that Jefferson College already has an excellent training facility. Graduates from its law enforcement academy go on to work across the state and nation. Because he does not understand what value the proposed \$50 million facility would bring to the county, he stated he cannot support it. Council Member Haskins agreed with Mr. Seek and also said he would vote against the bill. Council Members Groeteke, Tullock, and Councilwoman Arons expressed their support for the bill.
