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The Jefferson County, Missouri, County Council conducted a Regular Meeting on Monday, September 8, 2025, at Regular Meeting in the Assembly Room of the Jefferson County Administration Center, located at 729 Maple Street, Hillsboro, Missouri.

I. CALL TO ORDER

County Executive Dennis Gannon called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

VI. REPORTS AND COMMENTS FROM COUNCIL MEMBERS

District 1 - Councilman Brian Haskins:

Welcomed the media who were at the Council Meeting and thanked them for coming.
Gave an update on the pocket park located off of High Ridge Boulevard.

District 2 - Councilman Billy Crow Jr.:

Stated he had just attended his grandfather's funeral service, which was held at Jefferson Barracks. Mr. Crow said the gun salute and the playing of 'Taps' were deeply moving and thanked all veterans in our county and all those who keep us free.

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District 3 - Councilwoman Lori Arons:

Mentioned she attended a banquet commemorating Victory over Japan Day, which was 80 years ago. It was called "We'll Meet Again", a WWII tribute in song and story.

District 4 - Councilman Charles Groeteke:

Announced that this Thursday marks the 24th anniversary of the attacks on September 11th. He hopes that everyone will take a moment to reflect upon the attack against the United States of America.

Spoke about comments made to the Council regarding homelessness. Mr. Groeteke received a report from East-West Gateway who are backing a regional push to address the issue facing the unhoused called Bridge to Home.

District 5 - Councilman Scott Seek:

Mentioned this past weekend was the Twin City Days celebration and said it was well attended.

District 6 - Councilman Tim Brown:

Stated we are considering having the first Rules Committee meeting next Monday, either from 3 p.m. to 5 p.m., or it may be during the Work Session time at 6:30 p.m. Once a time has been decided it will be published.

District 7 - Councilman Bob Tullock:

Thanked all the veterans and mentioned that freedom is not free.

The County Services presentation that was going to be done at next Monday's Work Session is being postponed until October due to a scheduling conflict.

Mentioned he attended Judge Stuckmeyer's courtroom last week. He stated what he saw was very interesting and said the Judge had a lot of patience.

VII. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Mr. Gary Kappler - 822 Joachim Street, Festus, spoke regarding his family farm that borders Joachim Creek. Mr. Kappler stated his concerns regarding the proposed Bitcoin mining facility in Hematite, Missouri.

Mr. Alan Leaderbrand - 5062 Romaine Springs Drive, Fenton, spoke regarding the parks regulation change for entering Rockford Park. He mentioned the problem with this is that the County only owns up to the water's edge. Mr. Leaderbrand feels the ordinance should say it is illegal to enter the water from the park and leave the water in the park. He also mentioned he can't stop people from making stupid mistakes, but we need to protect our first responders.

Ms. Dawn Chadd - 1463 Scenic Drive, Arnold, stated she is concerned about the children in her neighborhood playing around a street with numerous derelict vehicles, trailers and boats and feels nothing is being done. Ms. Chad also mentioned a neighbor

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who is ill and passed out. The neighbor's husband did not call an ambulance because he felt it would not be able to make it up the street.

Ms. Carolyn Mitchell - 1069 William & Mary Court, Barnhart and Ms. Kelly Nichols - 3015 Leesburg Place, Imperial (*Executive Gannon allowed both to come up and speak together. However, they were told their time would only be 5 minutes total*). Ms. Mitchell stated they were there to ask for some help with a land issue they have had for 6 years. Both women in 2020 bought parcels of land in Cedar Hill, saying the only way to access this land was to cross a bridge over Belews Creek. Over the past 5 years, the bridge to access their land is flooding and proving difficult to maintain and would like to know if there is any assistance the county can recommend helping them with this large expense. Ms. Nichols stated Mr. VonArx did an evaluation of the bridge, and it was found to be deficient, including the permitting process. The bridge was permitted as an agricultural crossing, but was sold as residential property.

Mr. Patrick Stoll - 2769 Whitecreek Lane, Imperial, spoke regarding the termination of Valley Oaks from the street program.

Mr. Gene F. Barbagallo - 3216 Lions Den Road, Imperial, stated he had attended the last County Council Meeting and mentioned before the Public Comment section of each meeting everyone is instructed that this is not the time for personal attacks. He then proceeded to read the Standard Code of Parliamentary Procedures. Mr. Barbagallo said during the last Council Meeting it was very interesting and asked if there were two sets of rules.

County Executive Gannon stated the first hearing was a Public Hearing regarding the proposed amendments to the Code of Ordinances of Jefferson County, Missouri, Chapter 405: Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance, (Introduction Bill No. 25-09241).
