Mentioned that there has been a lot of interest in forming an Ad Hoc Committee to discuss the pros and cons of a Data Center. Mr. Gannon informed the Council that this week's East West Gateway Agenda has a report from one of their planners regarding Data Centers. He suggested that if someone has an interest, they log on to see what information they have.

We have applied for and received authorization from MODOT to do an airport study in Jefferson County. The RFP has been published and bids are due by November 18th.

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Mr. Gannon proposed dates to the Council for Budget Work Sessions.

Stated the Sales Tax for 2025 was 2.84% ahead of last year. We are not setting any records, but the increase is still ahead of last year.

So far, year-to-date recreational cannabis sales are \$738,000. This includes the protested amount.

XX. COUNTY COUNCIL MOTIONS REGARDING FUTURE AGENDAS

Council Member Charles Groeteke made a motion to add to a future agenda an ordinance to enact a temporary moratorium on the consideration of data centers in unincorporated Jefferson County, Missouri by the Jefferson County Planning and Zoning Commission, seconded by Councilwoman Lori Arons.

Mr. Groeteke explained that the purpose is to allow more time to research the various information available about data centers—their functions and their potential impact on citizens. Deputy County Counselor Jason Cordes noted that a procedural issue is being reviewed, which will determine how the matter comes before the Council.

Executive Gannon asked for clarification, but Mr. Cordes declined to discuss the issue in an open meeting and said a report will be provided to the County Council.

Council Member Bill Crow Jr. asked Mr. Groeteke whether the proposed bill includes a specific time limit for the moratorium that would require the Council to take action.

Mr. Groeteke responded that the bill's title refers to it as a temporary moratorium, intended to give the Council additional time to conduct research on various matters.

Council Member Scott Seek sarcastically stated he thinks we should not make America not first and said he thinks we ought to let the government completely control every bit of our lives. Let's make sure we don't make it, so businesses want to come into Jefferson County. Mr. Seek said obviously he was being facetious. Why put a moratorium on something that we don't even have yet and that people are talking about on social media? If we have a data center coming in, we have enough time to do the research right now.

Council Member Tim Brown stated that he was uncertain whether he would support the passage of the bill but expressed interest in reviewing its contents and potential impact. He also asked whether it would include a sunset clause.

Executive Gannon noted that Council Member Crow had expressed willingness to chair a Data Center Ad Hoc Committee. Mr. Gannon advised the Council to proceed with caution and ensure they are well-informed before drafting any ordinances.
