VII. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Council Member Billy Crow Jr. expressed his appreciation to all who applied for the appointment, as well as those who have filed to run in the upcoming election. He shared that he was once in a similar position, having applied for an appointment but not being selected. The following year, however, he ran in the election and was successful.

Council Member Groeteke also thanked the applicants, acknowledging the difficulty of the questions asked. He remarked that when he first applied for his position 15 years ago, he likely would not have been able to answer many of them.

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Councilwoman Lori Arons said that, having gone through the process herself two years ago, she understands the stress and pressure involved. She thanked all the applicants and encouraged those who were not selected to remain engaged and continue making a difference in their community.

Council Member Tullock added that four current Council Members were in the applicants' position not long ago, emphasizing that this experience is part of the journey in public service.

Mr. Bennett was called up to the podium where he was sworn in by County Clerk Jeanne Goff. After his swearing in Council Member Tim Bennett Jr. joined the other Council Members at the dais.

XXII. COUNTY COUNCIL MOTIONS REGARDING FUTURE AGENDAS

Council Member Charles Groeteke stated that he has recently been approached by county residents with questions regarding the guardianship of certain wards under the Department of Public Administration. He noted that he has also made inquiries about the department's operations—particularly concerning the financial conservatorship of estates, how they are administered, and how legal fees are paid—but has received limited information. He added that he previously requested that legal services for the department be put out for bid.

Mr. Groeteke reported that he has researched practices in counties similar to Jefferson County and reviewed an audit conducted in Clay County, Missouri. Based on this research, he believes an audit of the Jefferson County Public Administrator's Office is warranted.

Council Member Charles Groeteke made a motion to place a Resolution on the next agenda calling for an audit of the Jefferson County Department of Public Administration. The proposed audit would include a review of finances, operations, legal fees, and guardianship records (with personal information redacted).

Counselor Jasha Kuenzel asked who would conduct the audit. Mr. Groeteke responded that it could be performed either by the Jefferson County Auditor or by the State of Missouri, depending on what is permitted under state statutes.

Council Member Bob Tullock seconded the motion.

Council Member Brian Haskins stated that he would not support the motion, noting that he was unaware of any formal complaints or concerns regarding the department. He asked whether any specific issues had been identified. Mr. Haskins also remarked that, in his eight years on the Council, he had not seen a single department singled out for audit. He suggested that the Council might first consider auditing its own budget before auditing another department.

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County Executive Dennis Gannon stated that an audit is already underway. He explained that an independent third-party auditor is currently conducting the County's mandatory annual audit, which must be completed by June 2026. Rather than initiating a separate audit, he suggested amending the existing audit contract to include a more detailed review of the Public Administrator's Office.

Council Member Billy Crow Jr. recommended holding a Work Session to further discuss the matter before placing it on the next agenda. He also noted that conducting a separate audit would involve additional costs.
