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The Jefferson County, Missouri, County Council conducted a Regular Meeting on Monday, July 13, 2026, at Regular Meeting in the Assembly Room of the Jefferson County Administration Center, located at 729 Maple Street, Hillsboro, Missouri.

I. CALL TO ORDER

County Executive Dennis Gannon called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

VI. REPORTS AND COMMENTS FROM COUNCIL MEMBERS

District 1 - Councilman Brian Haskins:

Mr. Haskins shared that one of his constituents gave him a copy of the *St. Louis Business Journal*, dated April 24, 2026. The journal included a list of the largest home builders in the St. Louis market. Of the sixteen builders listed, only two were building in Jefferson County. He noted that there was a time when many of these major home builders were active in the county.

Mr. Haskins expressed concern about the future of Jefferson County's young adults, stating that the County should strive to provide affordable housing opportunities that encourage them to remain in the area. He said he hopes there are ways to attract more of these home builders back to Jefferson County, and that he believes doing so is important for the County's future.

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District 2 - Councilman Billy Crow Jr.:

Mr. Crow shared that he was able to participate in many of the Fourth of July festivities throughout Jefferson County. He complimented the organizers of the Hillsboro Fourth of July Festival, saying they did a wonderful job at the Fairgrounds. He also attended the annual Fourth of July Festival in Arnold, as well as celebrations held in several private communities.

Mr. Crow said it was wonderful to see so many people coming together to honor America and celebrate the nation's 250th Anniversary.

District 3 - Councilwoman Lori Arons:

Mrs. Arons stated that she wanted to take a moment to offer her thoughts and prayers for those affected by the recent flooding. As a lifelong camper, she expressed concern for the families who lost their campgrounds, their property, and their livelihoods for the remainder of the camping season. She shared that she had camped at many of those campgrounds over the years and asked everyone to keep in their thoughts the families whose homes and businesses were impacted by the thousand-year flood the previous week.

District 4 - Councilman Charles Groeteke:

Mr. Groeteke mentioned he had received information from the Missouri Department of Transportation. They are looking at potential traffic and safety improvements and additional upcoming repaving of U.S. 61/67 in Jefferson County, from Route 231 to Route Z. There will be a Public Meeting, Tuesday, July 21, 2026 4p.m. - 6 p.m. at Windsor High School. It will be an Open House format and there will not be a formal presentation.

Mr. Groeteke mentioned the East-west Gateway Board continues to work on addressing homelessness in the region. He shared that they are still working on the homeless problem and mentioned they gave an update regarding the Bridge to the Home Pilot Project Program, which is supposed to start later this year.

District 5 - Councilman Tim Bennett Jr.:

Mr. Bennett shared that District 5 also hosted many Fourth of July celebrations, which had impressive fireworks displays and were well attended.

Mr. Bennett also noted that the Festus Farmers Market is still ongoing and encouraged everyone to stop by and visit.

District 6 - Councilman Tim Brown:

The Council was reminded that if they had not yet turned in their current County-issued cell phone and received their new one, they should do so as soon as possible.

District 7 - Councilman Bob Tullock:

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Mr. Tullock stated he has recently spent a lot of time finding out the concerns of the public and said we have a lot of work ahead of us.

Mr. Tullock reported that he has been working with a business owner who is looking to relocate to a larger building within Jefferson County. He noted that Mayor Buddy Russell has been very helpful throughout the process.

Mr. Tullock also shared that he participated in a groundbreaking ceremony for a new business in Cedar Hill.

He concluded by extending his condolences to the families and loved ones of those who have recently passed away.
