Executive Dennis Gannon acknowledged the presence of both Todd Tracy, with Jefferson County Economical Corporation and Deborah Price, representing Missouri Partnership. Executive Gannon spoke regarding an ordinance seeking to use ARPA and Road Bridge funds for a proposed life changing development for Jefferson County, and many of its citizens. This may be the biggest and most important project this county has seen in years. County Counselor Wes Yates mentioned he had spoken with the Corporate Counsel for the company that is looking at Jefferson County to put their build their business. The project name for this ordinance is Project Redbird. The Corporate Counsel for the company has allowed the following information to be shared: It is a multinational corporation, the company has a net worth in the billions, it is a publicly traded corporation, the company has ten plants operating nationally, they intend to employ, (in a couple of phases), between 500 and 600 employees, if they located in Jefferson County.
