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The Jefferson County, Missouri, Council conducted a regular meeting on Monday, April 25, 2022, at 6:30 p.m. in the Assembly Room of the Jefferson County Administration Center, located at 729 Maple Street, Hillsboro, Missouri.

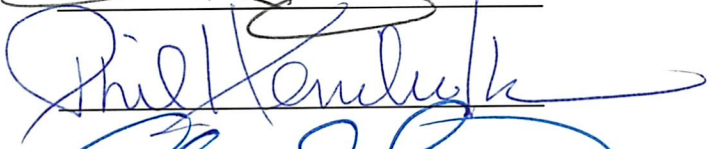
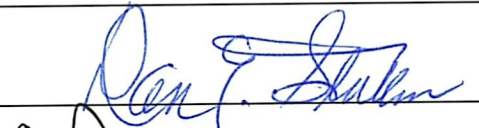
